Cabinet fittings

Brass is cast by the lost wax process from selected originals. An alloy is used that closely matches that used by 18thC foundries. Brass items are usually patinated. Simulated ivory is cast in rubber moulds using various materials.

Some items can be made in the material of your choice, the main limitation being availability of natural materials.

Genuine ivory and turtle are not available for export.

Escutcheons and monogram panels

Escutcheons and monogram panels can be copied in hardwoods such as box, ebony and satinwood, or horn, ivorite and pewter, (but not brass) from your original or from your plastic template. Ensure this is an accurate fit and mark the back and front .

Patterns should have a thickness of approx. 2mm with the edges tapered backwards at an angle of 5 degrees. Prices as above.

Caddy bowls

Hand blown lead crystal bowls with pontil mark for tea caddies. Measurements required are:- 24.00

1. The precise diameter of the wooden ring. It will probably be a slight oval so give the smallest measurement. We will try to supply a bowl one or two millimetres smaller than this.
2. The height of the ring from the base. Note that it is not unusual to have an original piece of packing in the bottom.
3.
 - i. If the tea compartments have a simple lid then we require the internal height above the ring, including the space inside the lid.
 - ii. If the caddy has separate drop in cannisters, then please give the distance from the top of the cannisters to the bottom of the compartment.

Black buffalo horn - Chinese

Slightly softer than the Indian but available in much larger pieces. Slightly softer than the Indian but available in much larger pieces. Solid tips up to 300mm long, weighing up to 1kg. Cost for 25gm. 1.00

Black buffalo horn - Indian

Sheets are approximately 2mm thick. Roughly 20cm² per 25gm. 6.00

Tip, solid pieces up to 300mm long, Weighing up to 500gms cost for 25gm. 1.00

Cow horn

Small solid tips. Only large enough to make parts for walking sticks or knobs and feet for small furniture. Size up to 50mm × 25mm. Each 2.00

Ivory

Not available for export. Mainly offcuts from a Victorian workshop. Please give details of pieces required. Price for 25gm. 10.00

Shell

Please send a fragment of your original for colour matching if possible.

Abalone

Small offcuts from a jewellery manufacturer. Assorted species approximately 1.5mm thick. Cost for 25gm 18.00

Abalone, red

Bonded from smaller pieces, the sheets are 80mm wide × 0.1mm thick. Cost for 10mm 2.00

Awabi

Sheet width is 80mm wide × 0.1 mm thick. Cost for 10mm 2.00

Mother of pearl

Irregular offcuts, usually under 25mm². Thickness approx 1.5mm. Grinding to shape is easiest on the side of a wetstone grinder. Cost for 25gms. 18.00

Mother of pearl sheet bonded from smaller pieces, the sheets are 80mm wide × 0.1mm thick. Cost for 10mm 2.00

Silver solution

Rubbing onto brass fittings plates it with silver, 50ml 12.00

Stringing

Brass 16g × 1/16" per ft. 1.50

Pewter –lead free 1.2 mm x 0.9mm per 100mm 1.00
